This role is responsible for maintaining safe working conditions around electrical infrastructure by clearing brush, trimming trees, operating equipment, and assisting with right-of-way inspections. This is an immediate opening, and applicants of all skill levels are encouraged to apply.

Minimum Requirements:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid Oklahoma Class A CDL with air brake endorsement
- Excellent driving record
- Ability to provide **three professional letters of recommendation**
- Must submit an **Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Operator Report** upon conditional job offer
- Pre-employment **drug screening** required; employment is contingent upon results

Preferred Experience:

- A minimum of six months prior experience in operating a chain saw, bucket truck, brush chipper and other power equipment.
- Prior experience in electrical right-of-way maintenance and clearing is preferred.

Key Responsibilities

- Perform vegetation removal and trimming to maintain electrical line clearance.
- Operate chainsaws, chippers, and related equipment safely and efficiently.
- Assist in the inspection of utility rights-of-way to identify hazards or obstructions.
- Follow all safety protocols related to electrical systems and outdoor field operations.
- Maintain accurate records of work performed and report potential issues to supervisors.
- Work effectively as part of a field crew in varying weather conditions and terrain.
